Season Tag Policies:

1. Family season tags are only sold to "families," as defined in the Village Code: *"All adult persons residing in the same household; and those minor children for whom the heads of household have legal guardianship and who reside with that guardian."*
2. Families may purchase a tag for babysitters, au pairs, and nannies by showing the individual resides at the same residence. All other addresses will require non-resident rates.
3. Only the person to whom the tag is issued, as shown above at the time of sale, may use the tag. Tags may not be transferred.
4. Tags must be displayed and worn at all times when lifeguards are present.
5. Beach patrons must abide by the beach rules. (see reverse side)
6. When there is no lifeguard on duty, swimmers swim at their own risk.

SPRING LAKE BEACH RULES

- ❖ All beach users are responsible to review beach rules as posted at the beach.
- ❖ If no lifeguard is on duty, swimmers swim at their own risk.
- ❖ If present, lifeguards are responsible for enforcing safety rules and responding to emergencies.
- ❖ Parents or guardians should supervise their children.
- ❖ Children, ages 10 and under, must be accompanied and supervised by an adult (18+).
- ❖ No one should swim alone.
- ❖ Entrance to the water shall only be from the beach.
- ❖ Patrons are encouraged to protect themselves from sun exposure.
- ❖ All children not toilet-trained shall wear tight-fitting rubber or plastic pants.
- ❖ Children with flotation devices must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- ❖ Persons under the age of 16 must be accompanied by a responsible person 16 years of age or older unless a lifeguard is present.
- ❖ All persons in the beach area, when a lifeguard is on duty, are required to pay a fee between the hours of 10:30 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.
- ❖ Appropriate beach attire is required at all times in the beach area.
- ❖ Swimmers of questionable skill are required to take and pass a swim test prior to being allowed on the water feature or in deep water.
- ❖ Season Tags or Daily Wristbands must be clearly visible to the lifeguard.
- ❖ The lake water is not suitable to drinking. Avoid swallowing lake water.
- ❖ Admission to the beach may be refused to all persons having any contagious disease, infectious conditions such as colds, fever, ringworm, foot infections, skin lesions, carbuncles, boils, diarrhea, vomiting, inflamed eyes, ear discharges, or any other condition which has the appearance of being infectious. Persons with excessive sunburn, abrasions, which have not healed, or bandages of any kind may also be refused admittance. A person under the influence of alcohol or exhibiting erratic behavior shall not be permitted in the beach area.
- ❖ Littering is prohibited. In addition, no alcohol, food, gum or tobacco is allowed on the beach or in the water.
- ❖ Glass containers are prohibited throughout the beach area.
- ❖ Personal conduct within the beach must be such that safety is not jeopardized.
- ❖ Diving is not permitted.
- ❖ Swimming is prohibited after sunset or before sunrise, or when lightning is present, including a 30 minute period after the last lightning is observed.
- ❖ No pets are permitted in the park or beach area.
- ❖ Feeding of wildlife or other actions that encourage their presence is prohibited and is subject to a fine under the Village Code.
- ❖ Groups of 15 to 30 persons must purchase a beach permit. Groups larger than 30 are prohibited.
