The Village of Lincolnshire is a cooperative member agency of the Special Recreation Association of Central Lake County (SRACLCL). The Association provides therapeutic recreation programs and services to people of all ages with disabilities or special needs. SRACLCL is a cooperative effort of the Grayslake, Mundelein, Libertyville and Vernon Hills Park Districts and the Villages of Lake Zurich, Hawthorn Woods and Lincolnshire. Individuals residing within the legal boundaries of the Member Agencies are considered "residents" of SRACLCL and may take advantage of the specialized leisure services available. Inclusion assistance for the Village is provided by SRACLCL.

SRACLCL program areas range from cultural arts, sports, adaptive sports and Special Olympics, to special events and day camps. SRACLCL recognizes that some people with disabilities prefer to participate in recreation programs within their own Park District or Recreation Department. SRACLCL can help with this opportunity by providing support in the form of extra staff, if deemed necessary, sign language interpreters, behavior management support, disability awareness training and other adaptive services necessary for safe and successful participation. INCLUSION: SRACLCL understands that not every person with a special need must participate in Special Recreation. SRACLCL staff can help with questions regarding the appropriateness of any individual's participation in local recreation programs.

If you are interested in participating in programs provided by the Village of Lincolnshire, please follow the registration procedures/timelines and contact the Village directly to state your requests. Always be open and honest when completing registration materials and state any special assistance that may be needed. It is important to inform Village staff what your goals and expectations are for you or your child in the program. By informing Village staff as soon as possible regarding special needs, SRACLCL staff are better able to provide the necessary assistance in a timely manner.

RESIDENT INFORMATION: Individuals residing within the legal boundaries of a SRACLCL Member Agency (Grayslake Community Park District, Mundelein Park and Recreation District, Vernon Hills Park District, Village of Hawthorn Woods, Village of Lake Zurich, Village of Libertyville, and Village of Lincolnshire) are considered "residents" of the Association and pay the in-district fee. Residents receive priority when registering for ALL PROGRAMS through the registration deadline.
