1.0 ROLL CALL

5.1 Parks and Paths Survey Questions

Management Analyst Barghi provided an updated draft of the survey questions that will be asked in the Parks and Paths survey that will hopefully be going out before the end of the year. Village staff and Park Board reviewed the questions and determined the following:

- If there is a need of eliminating a question, think about combining question #8 and #9 on the Parks and Paths Survey
- Remove the 'No Opinion' column on questions #5
- Add a comments box for each row in question #5. This will leave room for resident to explain reasons that their satisfied or unsatisfied.

- Add a 'Rate Importance' box next to each row in questions 5. This will give residents an opportunity to rank the importance level of each of these topics and will help staff prioritize the needs.

5.2 Interest of Park Board Members Attending Boo Bash Discussion

Management Analyst Barghi would like to have a Park Board 'meet and greet' at this year's Boo Bash. Park Board members have been asked to provide Management Analyst Barghi their availability for this event.

5.3 Spring Lake Park – Blue Star Memorial Pollinator Planting Complete

Management Analyst Barghi provided an update on the Pollinator Planting that was completed at Spring Lake Park. This area is now designated as a Monarch Waystation.

5.4 Rivershire Park Parking Lot Resurfacing Update

Management Analyst Barghi provided an update on the Rivershire Park parking lot resurfacing. The Village's contractor is currently completing the pavement milling with hopes that paving starts at the end of this week. The resurfacing portion of this project should be completed by the end of this month.

5.5 North Park Bathroom Update

Management Analyst Barghi provided an update on the North Park bathroom remodeling and expressed to the Park Board that this project should be complete by the 1st of October.

5.6 Cricket Pitch Findings Discussion

Management Analyst Barghi provided the Park Board with his initial findings on a Cricket Pitch. Mr. Barghi researched what it takes to have a cricket pitch, what the demand in the local area is and if this is something the Village could sustain here in Lincolnshire. While Mr. Barghi was researching this, he found that Stevenson is looking for a dedicated area where their students can practice on, play on and host tournaments at. Mr. Barghi was asked to research this topic further and provide feedback to the Park Board at the next meeting.

7.0 NEW BUSINESS

7.1 Consideration of an Ordinance Revising Title 8, Chapter 1, and Title 1, Chapter 15 of the Lincolnshire Village Code Pertaining to Park Usage

Public Works Director Woodbury provided the Park Board with the below recommended revisions in the Park's code:

- Eliminate beach permits
 - o Park Board was in agreeance to eliminate these permits.
- Added verbiage regarding the opening and closing of Park restrooms for Spring Lake and North Park.
 - o Park Board has advised staff to leave this section of the code and that there is no need to add verbiage
- Revisions to Pickleball playing hours
 - o Park Board directed staff to change the playing hours to 7:00 a.m. – Sunset for tennis, pickleball, and basketball.
 - o The code currently states that playing can only be done between April 1 - November 1. Park Board directed staff to eliminate this verbiage.

Member Fell moved, and Member Gurewitz seconded the motion to adjourn the Park Board Meeting. The voice vote was unanimous, and Chairman Borgerding declared the meeting adjourned at 8:30 p.m.
