Cardboard Boat Regatta Construction and Participation Guidelines



Construction Guidelines

1. The boat's hull must be made of corrugated cardboard and should be constructed and sealed with tape, caulk, and/or glue. Your boat may be painted if done more than 24 hours prior to putting it in the water.
2. Only corrugated cardboard may be used. Non-corrugated material may not be used (resin or wax-coated prohibited). No solid cardboard and no carpet roll tubes may be used to strengthen the hull or structure.
3. Above the hull, the boat may include additional materials as long as the materials do not aid its flotation.
4. Each boat must carry at least two team members.
5. Boats must be a maximum width of 60" (5ft) and a maximum length of 84" (7ft). No height requirement.

Pre-Race Guidelines

1. All boats must be inspected prior to the race by a member from the boat inspection team. All race participants must arrive at Spring Lake Beach by 11:45 a.m. for inspection. The race will begin immediately following the 4th of July Parade (anticipated noon).

Race Guidelines

2. Have fun, be creative, and always be safe! All participants should wear a Personal Floatation Device (PFD) at all times in or on the water.
3. Motors are not permitted. Participants must bring your own oar or paddle. Oars and paddles may be made of any material. Team members must supply their own towels.
4. All participants must be wearing a bathing suit and shorts. Crew costumes are encouraged!
5. Teams are not allowed to sabotage anyone else's boat. Any rough housing will lead to disqualification.
6. Team members who start the race must finish the race without leaving the interior of the boat. Leaving the boat during the race will disqualify the entire team.
7. When a boat is finished with the race, the team must remove the boat and any leftover cardboard debris from the water area and dispose of it at the designated trash area.
8. Prizes will be awarded for *Fastest Boat* in each heat, *Grand Finale* winner, and *Submarine Award*.
