Super Fans Don't Let Super Friends Drive Impaired

(LINCOLNSHIRE, III.) The Village of Lincolnshire Police Department conducted extra enforcement geared towards impaired drivers on Super Bowl Sunday with six local police departments for a 2/2 on Route 22 (Half Day Road) safety campaign.

With the assistance of the Bannockburn Police Department, Buffalo Grove Police Department, Fox River Grove Police Department, Highland Park Police Department, Lake Zurich Police Department, and the Lake County Sheriff's Office, the following results were yielded:

- 31 speeding citations
- Four driving under the influence of alcohol arrests
- Four driving while license suspended/revoked/no valid arrests
- Three distracted driving citations
- Two illegal transportation of alcohol citations
- Two operating uninsured motor vehicle citations
- Eight other traffic citations
- 20 written warnings

The Illinois "Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over" and "Click It or Ticket" programs are administered by the Illinois Department of Transportation with federal highway safety funds managed by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration.
