### **Nationwide Speeding Safety Campaign Results**

**(LINCOLNSHIRE, ILL.)** The Lincolnshire Police Department participated in the Memorial Day traffic safety campaign "*Stop Speeding Before it Stops You*" from May 18 to June 1.

The campaign was conducted in conjunction with hundreds of other police departments across the country and is administered by the Illinois Department of Transportation with federal highway safety funds managed by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA).

Lincolnshire Police Officers conducted the following enforcement activities:

- One arrest for driving while license suspended
- One arrest for driving while license revoked
- Five arrests for speeding in excess of 26 mph over the posted speed limit
- 50 speeding citations
- One citation for operating an uninsured vehicle
- One citation for distracted driving
- One citation for disobeying a traffic control device

The Police Department continues to remind all drivers to help protect everyone using our roadways, especially with the summer months ahead and the anticipated increase in pedestrian and bicycle traffic. Please remember – *stop speeding before it stops you!*
