### **Lincolnshire's September Spring Clean Up**

**(LINCOLNSHIRE, III.)** The Village of Lincolnshire rescheduled its annual spring clean up to Saturday, September 26.

The Village, in conjunction with Waste Management, offers residents an opportunity to dispose of household goods that wouldn't normally be accepted in weekly refuse collection. Commonly disposed materials include:

- Small furniture such as chairs and tables
- Carpet and lumber – bundled in lengths not more than four feet long by two feet wide
- Construction debris – not more than one cubic yard and weighing less than 50 pounds
- Plumbing fixtures
- Small vehicle parts – drained of oil and gas
- Mattresses and box springs
- Empty water softeners

All goods must be placed at the curb by 7 a.m. on September 26 and must be a size manageable for one person to lift.

However, appliances, household chemical waste, and landscape waste will not be accepted by Waste Management on Saturday. Residents who wish to dispose of these items should visit the Solid Waste Agency of Lake County (SWALCO) website at [www.swalco.org](http://www.swalco.org) for disposal locations.

Spring clean up was originally scheduled for April 18, 2020, but was postponed by Waste Management due to COVID-19. The 2021 spring clean up is still scheduled for mid-April.

Additionally, residents can dispose of landscape waste by purchasing collection stickers from Village Hall, the Lincolnshire Walgreens, or Waste Management. Landscape waste should be bagged and placed at the curb for Waste Management to collect on regularly scheduled refuse collection days. Residents can also wait to dispose leaves until the Village's annual leaf collection program in mid- to late- October.
