Lincolnshire Completes Summer's End Speed Enforcement Campaign

(Lincolnshire, Ill) The Lincolnshire Police Department increased reckless driving patrols from September 11 to September 30. The increased patrols targeted speeding and dangerous drivers as part of a campaign funded by the Illinois Department of Transportation.

The Lincolnshire Police conducted 16 additional patrols which totaled 67.5 hours and 141 total traffic stops. Those traffic stops resulted in:

- 130 speeding citations
- Two arrests for driving while license suspended
- One distracted driving citation
- Seven other traffic citations
- Nine written warnings

Speeding remains a significant problem in Lincolnshire. Illinois remains in the top four states for having the most speeding-related traffic crashes with fatalities.

The Police Department reminds all motorists the residential speed limit in Lincolnshire is 20 mph.

Help protect everyone using our roadways, especially with the anticipated increase in pedestrian and bicycle traffic due to students returning to in-person learning. Please remember – *stop speeding before it stops you!*
