Lincolnshire Police Respond to Staffing Issues at Nursing Facility

(LINCOLNSHIRE, Ill.) The Lincolnshire Police Department received a report of a severe staffing concern at The Wealshire, LLC rehabilitation facility on May 1 at 9:11 a.m.

The facility, located at 150 Jamestown Lane, is typically staffed with over 60 employees; however, there were approximately one-third of staff members present for work.

Due to public health safety concerns, the Police Department worked in conjunction with the Lincolnshire-Riverwoods Fire Protection District (LRFDP) to address the situation, and the Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) was notified. LRFDP transported three individuals to Advocate Condell Medical Center in Libertyville for medical treatment. Former staff members were called to assist with the matter and are currently caring for individuals at the facility.

The rehabilitation facility previously operated as Warren Barr Rehab Facility; however, Village staff were notified that The Wealshire, LLC assumed all operations as of May 1, 2023.

IDPH is the regulatory agency responsible for ensuring nursing homes comply fully with mandatory state regulations. The Lincolnshire Police Department will continue to work with IDPH while investigating this matter.

The Village of Lincolnshire, 1957, is a northern suburb of Chicago and is conveniently adjacent to the Tri-State Tollway. Lincolnshire is home to 7,940 residents, two nationally-recognized public school districts, and over 400 businesses – a number of which are global headquarters and Fortune 500 companies.
