Administrative Assistant Retires After 24 Years in Public Service

(LINCOLNSHIRE, ILL.) Carol Lustig, Administrative Assistant for the Community & Economic Development Department, will retire on July 10 after 24 years in public service, with nearly seven years spent serving the Village of Lincolnshire.

Lustig, who was hired in Lincolnshire in December 2016, spent her career working in various community development departments throughout the Chicago region including Arlington Heights, Lake Zurich, and Highland Park.

A licensed Permit Technician through the International Code Council, Lustig served as the point person for all incoming building permits for the Village. During her time with Lincolnshire, Lustig played a key role in issuing nearly 3,000 building permits and scheduling more than 13,000 inspections, with a total construction value of more than \$235 million.

"Carol's smile, friendly voice, and warm demeanor put residents, business owners, and contractors at ease and ensured their projects would be reviewed and permits issued as quickly and safely as possible. Her professionalism and composure are testaments to her passion for public service," Ben Roesler, Assistant Village Manager/Community & Economic Development Director, said. "Carol set the example for what it means to take pride in one's work while also being a phenomenal teammate. I wish I could work with Carol for the rest of my career, but she's gone above and beyond to help the community, and she deserves all the best retirement has to offer."

Mayor Elizabeth J. Brandt issued a proclamation honoring Lustig's public service during the June 26 Regular Village Board meeting.

The Community & Economic Development Department is responsible for all phases of the building and construction process; code enforcement; planning and zoning; and economic development.
