St. Patrick's Day Extra Enforcement Ensures Safer Roads

(LINCOLNSHIRE, ILL.) The Lincolnshire Police Department joined police agencies across the country to target St. Patrick's Day impaired driving and speeding violations from March 12 to March 18.

The St. Patrick's Day traffic safety campaign yielded the following results:

- One driving under the influence arrest
- Two arrests for speeding in excess of 26 over the speed limit
- Two uninsured motor vehicle citations
- 25 speeding citations
- Two other traffic violation citations
- Three written warnings for traffic violations

The Illinois "Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over" and "Click It or Ticket" campaigns are administered by the Illinois Department of Transportation with federal highway safety funds managed by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration.
