# PROJECT DETAILS

The 2019 Crosstown watermain project is an \$800,000 watermain improvement carrying on the Village's master plan for improving water pressure and reliability throughout the Village.

This project is a continuation of previous installations done east of Queens Way near the tollway.

This project will include the installation of watermain from the intersection of Queens Way and Canterbury Road westerly down Regent Lane/Kings Cross Drive to Buckingham Place terminating in the Riverwoods Road right-of-way at Buckingham Place.

Future projects will extend this watermain north and south along Riverwoods Road for ultimate connection to the Village watermain system.

This new watermain will be placed in the roadway and patching of the roadway is proposed.

This project is scheduled to be completed in late July 2019.

The following work will be completed:

- ⇒ 3,700 feet of 12 inch watermain with new fire hydrants
- ⇒ storm sewer pipe and structure replacements
- ⇒ roadway patching
- ⇒ landscape restoration

**Please note it is the residents' responsibility to inform the Village about any irrigation or invisible fences; the contractor is not responsible for those items installed in the public right-of-way.**



## FAQS

### When will this work begin and be finished?

The project is scheduled to begin early June and be completed late July 2019, weather permitting.

### What are the work hours for this project?

Work hours are planned for 7am-7pm, Monday-Friday and 9am-5pm, Saturdays; no work on Sundays.

### Will roads be closed during construction?

With the exception of Buckingham Place, all roads will remain open. Westbound Buckingham Place will be shutdown for 2-3 days for watermain installation; residents will be allowed driveway access during this time. Please see the map.

### Will I have access to my driveway?

Access will be affected only while work is being performed at your driveway. You will be informed in advance of any necessary closures. The Village understands the inconvenience of these closures and hopes to keep them to a minimum. If there are any concerns regarding access, please notify one of the contacts in this brochure as early as possible so that arrangements can be made.

### Will my garbage be picked up?

Yes, garbage service will continue.

### Will my mail be delivered?

Yes; locations for clusters of mailboxes with your address will be installed for you to retrieve your mail. Please get in touch with one of the contacts in this brochure or your local Post Office with any questions.

### Where can I park my car?

When access to your driveway is affected, you will be informed in advance where parking will be permitted.

### Can my landscaper park on the roadway?

No; your landscaper can park in your driveway or on an adjacent street.

### Will my water be shut off during watermain construction?

Yes, your water will be shut down for a short time during the project. It will take the construction crew a couple of hours to connect new hydrants to the existing main. You will be notified in advance of the shutdown. The Village greatly understands this inconvenience and appreciates your understanding; crews will do their best to get water up and running as soon as possible.

### Can we drink the water during watermain construction?

Your water will be safe to drink during construction with the exception of when you are under a temporary boil order; you will be notified in advance of any water shutdowns and boil orders.
