Dear Lincolnshire Resident:

This letter is to provide an update on storm water drainage improvements being contemplated for your area as a result of the 2020 Village-Wide Drainage Study completed earlier this year. The study identified over \$20 million in potential drainage improvements. As the Village works its way through the budgeting process to identify a funding source for these improvements, preliminary data collection efforts are slated to begin in your neighborhood over the next few months. This information will allow the Village to begin the early design stages of the projects being considered and assist in the development of potential grant applications for these projects. The overall goal of the projects identified in the 2020 Village-Wide Drainage Study is to reduce roadway flooding during large rainfall events. A side benefit to these projects may be the opportunity to enhance opportunities for private drainage improvements as well. Additional information on private drainage accommodations as well as construction timing will be provided to you as project scope, required permitting, approvals, and funding details are finalized.

Surveyors from consultants working for the Village will be collecting data on roadways and may also take measurements on private property throughout the rest of the year. Please allow them to access your property as needed to collect information on behalf of the Village of Lincolnshire.
